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two destinies intersect in this novel that of Gjorgj a young mountaineer who has just killed a man in order to avenge the death of his older brother and who expects to be killed himself in

keeping with the code of the highlands and that of a young couple who have come to study the age old customs including the blood feud

the aim of the present study is to analyse how issues of albanian national identity are portrayed in ismail kadaré s novel broken april prilli i thyer and how such features have been appropriated and translated onto the screen into a northeastern brazilian context i depart from the premise that even though brazilian elements are indeed shown in the film the non existence of the kanun in brazil and the use of narrative techniques different from the ones employed in the novel render the story of the blood feuds in the film more universal than the genuinely albanian reality depicted in the novel in sum the appropriation transcends the albanian reality into a universal context showing at the same time elements which are typical of the brazilian culture

in should blood blend with milk dena fakhro offers an account of middle eastern conflicts told from the perspective of arabic poetry and the blood feud far from being confined to antiquity verse promoting bloody retribution continues to be generated by armed groups whereas among moderates there are lampoons which instead serve as protest and warning traditionally blood vengeance is a requirement for settling scores and restoring honour to injured parties by making wide use of poems ranging from pre islamic arabia the medieval caliphates and the modern map of the middle east fakhro proves these texts belong to an epic continuum employing recurrent language while contextualising revenge as an aspect of sectarianism border conflict between empires anti colonial resistance and militant jihadism

this edited collection introduces and defines the concept of comparative restorative justice putting it in the context of power relations and inequality it aims to compare the implementation and theoretical development of restorative justice internationally for research policy and practice in part i this volume compares practices in relation to the implementing environment be that cultural political or societal part ii looks at obstacles and enablers in relation to the criminal justice system and considers whether inquisitorial versus adversarial jurisdictions have impact on how restorative justice is regulated and implemented finally part iii compares the reasons that drive governments regional bodies and practitioners to implement restorative justice and whether these impetuses impact on ultimate delivery featuring fifteen original chapters from diverse authors and practitioners this will serve as a key resource for those working in social justice or those seeking to understand and implement the tenets of restorative justice comparatively

in 1945 albania was an extremely under developed nation compared to other countries in europe so in studying enver hoxha s forty year reign 1945 85 it is necessary to recognize him as a leader who accomplished great things for albania while concurrently enmeshing the country in policies that were not only counterproductive but self destructive this book studies a wide range of areas pertaining to hoxha s impact upon albania s development o donnell shows that while it is necessary to give hoxha a mixed report card he nonetheless enabled a

small nation with a multitude of limitations to maintain its sovereignty and modernize through unorthodox methods

elidor mëhilli has produced a groundbreaking history of communist albania that illuminates one of europe's longest but least understood dictatorships from stalin to mao which is informed throughout by mëhilli's unprecedented access to previously restricted archives captures the powerful globalism of post 1945 socialism as well as the unintended consequences of cross border exchanges from the mediterranean to east asia after a decade of vigorous borrowing from the soviet union advisers factories school textbooks urban plans albania's party clique switched allegiance to china during the 1960s sino soviet conflict seeing in mao's patronage an opportunity to keep stalinism alive mëhilli shows how socialism created a shared transnational material and mental culture still evident today around eurasia but it failed to generate political unity combining an analysis of ideology with a sharp sense of geopolitics he brings into view fascist italy's involvement in albania then explores the country's eastern bloc entanglements the profound fascination with the soviets and the contradictions of the dramatic anti soviet turn richly illustrated with never before published photographs from stalin to mao draws on a wealth of albanian russian german british italian czech and american archival sources in addition to fiction interviews and memoirs mëhilli's fresh perspective on the soviet chinese battle for the soul of revolution in the global cold war also illuminates the paradoxes of state planning in the twentieth century

making a country great again is a theme for nationalist authoritarians across countries with past experience as great powers nationalist politicians typically harken back to a golden age in nostalgia for empire hakan yavuz focuses on how this trend is playing out in turkey a nation that lost its empire a century ago and which is now ruled by a nationalist authoritarian who invokes nostalgia for the ottoman era to buttress his power yavuz delves into the social and political origins of expressions of nostalgia for the ottoman empire among various groups in turkey exploring why and how certain segments of turkish society has selectively brought the ottoman empire back into public consciousness yavuz traces how memory of the ottoman period has changed he draws from turkish literature mainstream history books and other cultural products from the 1940s to the twenty first century to illustrate the transformation he finds that two key aspects of turkish literature are on the one hand its criticism of the jacobin modernization of turkey under ataturk and on the other a desire to search the ottoman past for an alternative political language yavuz goes on to explain how major political actors including president erdogan utilize the concept of empire to craft distinctive conceptualizations of nationalism islam and ottomanism that exploit national nostalgia as remembered today the ottoman past seems to be grounded in contemporary conservative islamic values the combination of these memories and values generates a portrait of turkey as a victim of major powers besieged by imagined enemies both internal and external in mapping out how nostalgia is crafted and spread this book not only sheds light on turkey's unique case but also deepens our understanding of nationalism religion and modernity

in the last year of world war ii the narrator of the plague spreader s tale is sent to a tuberculosis sanatorium near palermo the place is like a leper colony people arrive but they never leave until they are dead usually within a matter of months the narrator is a young man straight out of the army who has been diagnosed with the fatal disease the doctor is a lean rake of a man who like most of the medical staff has the illness in his cells however the sap of life cannot be stopped from flowing and the narrator falls in love with a woman patient she was once a ballerina and has not lost her grace she leads her suitor a merry dance as her attitude varies from the come hither to cloistered retreat how much of a future can the pair build for themselves on these shifting sands

this theologically informed study in economic ethics focuses on the world market as an ideology a formal theory and a practical device it analyzes the tendency of economists to elaborate and impose market theory as dogma such approaches are contrasted with principles of justice found in the sermon on the mount matthew 5 7 the parable of the sheep and goats matthew 25 31 46 and the reformed protestant social theory of 16th century theologian john calvin the author concludes that market mechanisms must be supplemented by additional tools to ensure that world needs are fairly and correctly met
